



Application & Enrollment Fee

- \$150.00 Registration Fee* (per student, non-refundable)
- \$100.00 Application and Testing Fee (per student, new families only, due at test administration)

**Registration is not complete until the Registration Fee has been received.*

Book and Supply Fee (due by May 1st, non-refundable)

- \$450.00 per student Kindergarten-8th Grade

Payment Options

- A 10% discount is applied for tuition paid in full (*by cash or check*) by Aug 1st.
- Monthly payments are due Aug through May. FACTS Tuition Management setup is required.
- Book and Supply Fee due May 1st or will be added to July FACTS.
- Step Up and Family Empowerment scholarship paperwork is required at enrollment.

Withdrawal Policy

Application, Registration, Book & Supply Fee are non-refundable; refunds for tuition are given on a pro-rated scale based on the withdrawal date. Technology must be returned within seven days of the withdrawal date.

Extended Care

Early Morning Care is available to students in Kindergarten to Grade 8 (6:45 am-7:50 am)

Afternoon Care is available to students in Kindergarten to Grade 8 (3:00 pm to 5:30 pm daily, 12:00 noon to 5:30 pm on early release days)
